The partnership with EDF R brings global and local expertise and experience to support the development of significant solar power and energy storage projects in the Hunter region.

This strategy has been enhanced by the NSW Government recently designating the Hunter-Central Coast a Renewable Energy Zone.

EDF R is a world leader in renewable energy with a presence in more than 20 countries, with 10.1 GW net installed capacity of solar, onshore wind, offshore wind and storage projects as of December 31st 2021.
