Malabar is supporting the transition of industries in the Upper Hunter region which have primarily comprised of open cut thermal coal production and coal-fired power generation.

Maxwell Underground Mine

Health and Safety

Malabar is committed to the health and safety of its people and achieving zero harm. No notifiable incidents recorded to date for the 2022 calendar year.

Malabar has implemented policies and procedures to address the on-going risks of COVID-19 and continues to monitor government requirements for compliance. There has been minimal disruption at site due to COVID-19.

Project activity

Malabar selected Pybar Mining Services (Pybar) as the preferred contractor for the drift development.

Other construction-related activities during the quarter included inviting and evaluating tenders for all the critical path activities and equipment including:

- the access road,
- construction of the mine entry area,
- services (e.g. power and water supplies),
- mining, conveying and ventilation equipment, and;
- rail services.

Spur Hill Underground Project

Malabar holds Exploration Licence (EL) 7429.

2D seismic will be undertaken to better define a geological feature called the "Eastern Boundary Fault" which separates the Maxwell coal reserves from those in the Spur Hill EL.

This work has been delayed due to Covid and then, more recently, adverse weather.

The fieldwork is forecast to be completed this year.

Malabar Renewables

Studies continue in partnership with EDF Renewables (EDF-R) to determine the development parameters and strategy for large-scale solar generation.

The partnership with EDF-R brings global and local expertise for large scale solar development in the Upper Hunter region. EDF-R has a presence in more than twenty-two countries with its renewable generation portfolio exceeding 15,000 MW from solar and wind.

Environment

Quarterly activities

- Autumn tree bed preparations commencing in April 2022 with approximately 13,000 trees to be planted in May 2022. On completion total trees planted for rehabilitation will exceed 200,000;
- Annual fauna and flora monitoring completed with results showing that grassland rehabilitation areas are progressing well towards closure criteria;
- Continued targeted weed control and feral animal management on mine rehabilitation and offset areas; and
- Continuation of the mine rehabilitation cattle grazing trial with a local farmer from Denman.

Corporate Activities

Malabar is progressing well with completing the funding package to develop the Maxwell Underground Mine. In the March quarter the following progress has been made:

- Agreed favourable deferred payment terms from key equipment suppliers;
- Senior debt term sheets have been received and continued to be negotiated; and
- Ongoing discussion with potential customers on coal offtake and funding arrangements.

The focus for the June quarter is finalising the senior debt financing and commencing the equity raise to complete the funding package required for the Maxwell Underground Mine.
